### Assembly - Seating information

The setup of the Plenary Hall cannot be modified and, due to high attendance at the 148th Assembly, seating is limited. Therefore, each delegation has been allocated sufficient seats for its Governing Council members (maximum three). For those delegations from countries with a population of more than 100 million inhabitants an additional seat has been allocated and, where possible, delegations led by Speakers also have an additional seat.

Observer delegations will not have assigned individual seating, but may sit in the Observers area, towards the back of the Hall. Delegation members and staff, as well as Observers, who do not have seats in the Plenary, are invited to go the Galleries located on either side of the Hall.
