Easy Access


Offline Briefcase

PIN Lock (Auto lock) Fingerprint Option


Allows secured offline access to Briefcased Documents

Ability to Select between Senate, National Assembly or the Secretariat








Briefcase for storing documents when offline




View House Business on the National Assembly










View Member deatils of both Senate and National Assembly




Resources tab that allows members to view documents such as for that of respective committees










Senate View of eParKenya which allows them to view House Business, Track Bills and Motions among other functionalities



- Automated power saving measures e.g screen savers, automatic power slip mode


